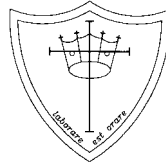


# School

Please come along to the meeting and tell us what you think.

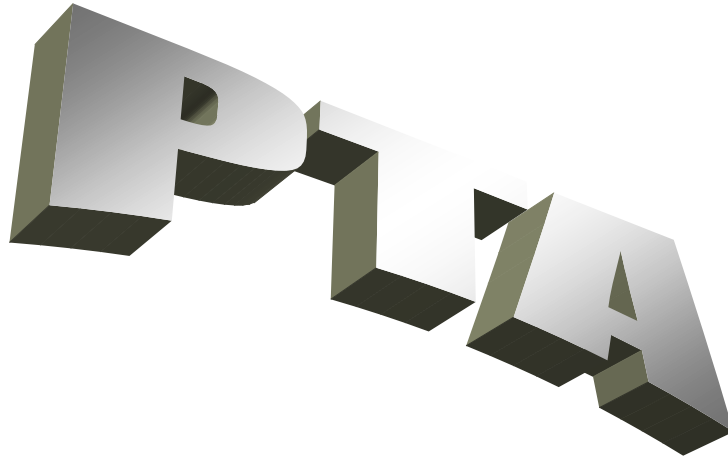
