Dear Parents,

You will be aware that at Christ The King School we have a strong tradition of swimming success and we are fully committed to providing an annual swimming programme (for our juniors).

Each of the classes participates in lessons for a number of weeks, for a 1 hour intensive swimming session.

To ensure that the children arrive on time and safely in all weathers we have used the services of a local coach company. However, the cost of providing transport together with the cost of the lesson per child has gradually increased over the years and it has become incredibly difficult to meet the costs from within the school's budget. I am therefore asking for your support in voluntarily contributing £1 per week towards the cost of transport. For the weeks your child attends swimming lessons, which would be for 8 weeks, the contribution therefore would be £8.

Your voluntary contribution will go some way towards the amount of money school has to find for the transport costs. (not the lesson itself) and the swimming programme can continue in its current format.

You can make a contribution either for £8 or £1 per week whilst your child attends the pool. (Please see reply slip).
