Brunel was known for wearing a tall black top hat – stylish in Victorian times! He built The Clifton Bridge in Bristol. It was a suspension bridge, and very high so ships could sail under it. Brunel built Paddington Station (1854) in London. Trains still use it. Brunel wanted to build the world's biggest ship – the Great Eastern.
