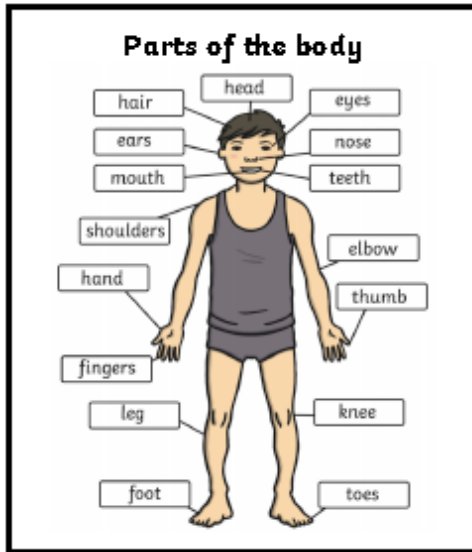








| mammal | Animals with fur, that feed their babies with milk. |
| bird | A warm-blooded, egg-laying animal with wings and feathers. |
| amphibian | A cold blooded animal with moist skin and webbed feet. |
| reptile | A cold blooded animal with scales and dry skin. |
| insect | A group of very small animals that have segmented bodies. |
| fish | Cold-blooded animals that live in water, have gills, fins, and a tail. |
| wild | Animals who live in nature and not tamed. |
| pet | Animals who are tamed and live in a home. |

Herbivore

An animal that only likes to eat plants.



Omnivore

An animal that likes to eat plants and meat.



Carnivore

An animal that only likes to eat meat.
