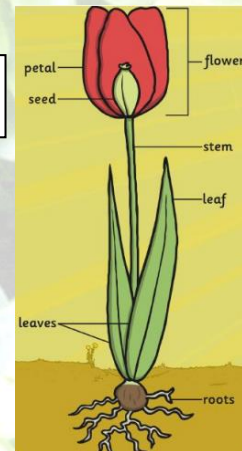


Vocabulary	Meaning
Roots	Anchor the plant in the ground and takes up nutrients and water from the soil.
Stem	Takes the water from the roots and takes it to the different parts of the plant.
Leaves	Uses sunshine to make food for the plant.
Flower	The part of the plant that attracts insects.
Petal	Thin coloured parts that form the flower
Fruit	The part of the plant that has the seeds.
Seeds	These are scattered on the ground to create new plants or trees.
Trunk	The trunk is the tree's stem.
Branches	The parts that grow out from the trunk of a tree and have leaves, flowers or fruit growing on them.
Bark	A tough material that covers the outside of the tree

Types of trees			
Deciduous	A tree that has leaves which drop off every year.	Evergreen	Trees which stay green all year.
