16 th AUG 1819	Manchester (England)	The Peterloo Massacre, St. Peter's Field, Manchester. Peaceful protest is met with force and violence as workers campaign for better working conditions.	Liberty / Massacre	
1833	Dorset (England)	A group of farm workers met in a bid to rid themselves of poverty. They try to persuade landowners to pay a fair wage for a fair days work. They are arrested, then deported to Australia and sentenced to hard labour.	Oath / Deported / Union	
1903	Manchester	The Women's Social and Political Movement was set up in a bid to fight for equality for women. The Suffragettes campaigned in various ways to fight for their cause and secure the vote.	Suffrage / Rights	
1933 - 1945	Germany	Hitler's rise to power. How the National Socialist party came to rule Germany through democratic means.	Democracy / Tyranny	
1938	Germany	Hitler begins his campaign to blame Jews for Germany's post WW1 problems and sets out to segregate and alienate them from society. (Kristallnacht)	Segregation / Prejudice	
1939	Czechoslovakia	Nicholas Winton sets up the Kindertransport to rescue Jewish children from the impending horrors of the Holocaust	Valediction / Refuge / Refugee	
1 st Sept 1939-2 nd Sept 1945	Europe	Nazi Germany's invasion of Poland on the 1 st September 1939 and subsequent occupation of countries in Europe allowed Hitler to carry out his plans on an enormous scale.	Invasion / Occupation
