Children's University is a programme that allows children to earn 'credits' for their extracurricular activities, that being any learning that takes place outside curriculum hours. When the children attend an after school club (see our School Clubs tab) they will earn a credit for every hour they attend. This will build up over the year – the more clubs attended, the more credits earned! All credits earned last year will roll over and be added to this year.

This year we are introducing the 'Passports to Learning'. These enable the children to earn credits when they attend a club outside of school. The club must be accredited with the Children's University for the children to be able to log their hours (your provider will be able to let you know if they are). Passports are available from school at a cost of £2.50 (payable via Parent Pay).

In July there will be a Graduation Ceremony held at Salford University where any child (Year 3 and above) who have earned at least 30 credits will receive an award at a Graduation Ceremony – complete with cap and gown!
