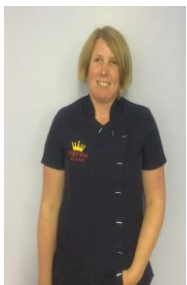
## Breakfast and After School Club

Dear Parents/Carers,

As you may be aware we have set up wrap around care at CTK. We run a Breakfast Club from 7.45, providing a choice of breakfast and activities and an After School Club from 3.30-5.45, providing a snack and a range of fun activities.

The club is run with ideas reflected by the children. It is their club and we want them to have their say. They are encouraged to write ideas on the board or put their name next to ideas we have found for them. This helps us to plan for activities the children will enjoy. If they have interests or talents we will help them to explore these. Please fill out the 'All about me' booklet, this can be downloaded from our website so we can get to know your child better. There is a small circle time at the start of each evening, where we have games or a chat about our day or discuss new ideas for the club. Then we have a snack and play. There is an adult led activity available each day too.

To help the 'Early Years' children settle in the club, we have Key workers that already work with your children in school.

- The role of the key person is to help your child to settle in at the Club, and to ensure that our care is tailored to meet the individual needs of your child.
- If you have any problems, concerns or achievements that you would like to discuss with the Club, please speak to your key person in the first instance.
- If you ever need to access specialist support for your child, your key person will help to point you in the right direction.
- Your child's key person will discuss with you (and other providers if appropriate) the support that your child may require to help them develop the skills to learn effectively.

We are all enjoying our time at King's Kids, having so much fun as we play and explore together.

If you are interested in the club then please feel free to approach me (Mrs Horrocks) or any of the Play workers and we can show you around the club room and other areas we use. You can also email or ring the school.

Please book on through Parent Pay to secure your child's place. If you would like to look around the room or bring your child ahead of a booking to see the room then please ask, alternatively their Key worker could bring them at a quieter time of day to see the room. Please ask. I am happy to help parents to learn how to navigate the booking on procedure if you are having difficulty, ring or call into the club to see me.

It is imperative you book on in advance through the calendar so we are aware your child will be attending. This is essential for safety and child/adult ratio numbers as well as being able to plan food and activities.

Please note: The booking in system will be locked two days in advance but you can book on or ring the school on the day or the day before for last minute requests. Please always ask as we may have places available.
