It has come to our attention that comments are being made on Social Media regarding our school, employees and pupils. At the beginning of each year, parents are asked to read the Acceptable User Policy and E-Safety policy along with their children and a letter is signed by the parent/carer as confirmation. The letter signed states the following:

“Our E-Safety Policy is in place to keep the whole school community safe and effective in its ICT practices. It is important to note that school deems any use of IT (including Social Media) which brings the reputation of the school and/or Catholic Community into disrepute and criticism of actions stemming from the fact of its Catholic nature will be taken as serious breaches. Appropriate actions will be taken and we recommend that you use the school’s complaint procedure”

As a general rule, schools are orderly, safe places where relationships between staff and parents demonstrate mutual respect and a recognition of shared responsibility for pupils’ welfare and educational progress. Parental involvement is an important factor in educational success and in dealing with emerging problems at an early stage. As a school we strive to be approachable and to ensure that as parents you are an important part of your children’s education. If you have a concern about the school or your child’s education please do not hesitate to raise it with the school. Please discuss any concerns with the appropriate member of staff or use the school’s Complaints Policy. Please do not use Facebook or other social media to air a grievance. It is hugely discouraging for staff and members of the school community, has a potentially enormous audience and, importantly, does not afford the school with an opportunity to respond or address the grievance.
