1. Christmas Family Do

DATE: Sunday, 18th December.

VENUE: Ellesmere Sports Club (as the golf club isn't holding children's parties anymore).

There is a small problem as it is the same day as the world cup final.

The event could include a chocolate tombola, raffle, bar and food, though we need to establish whether or not the venue allows you to bring your own food in.

2. Christmas Film Night

DATE: Monday, 12th December

VENUE: School hall.

Proposed time: 4:30 – 6:30 so that children across the whole school can attend and it isn't too late for the Early Years children. Children would come into school with their pyjamas, if they were in Kings Kids and get changed at school and stay through until the film is finished. All other children would go home and get changed into their pyjamas before returning to school. Parents would pick up at 6:30. There would be a small charge to cover popcorn, hotdog and drinks and some help would be needed to set everything up.

3. Other Christmas activities
